



A Special meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, November 21, 2022 beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, Texas with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners, Pct. 1- Jeff Williams, Pct. 2-Charles Morris and not present was Pct. 3-Ted Brannon. County officials present: Terri Laurence, District & County Clerk; Terry Morgan, Sheriff; LuAnne Terry, Treasurer and Ted Weems, County Attorney. Also present: Carol Williams, Administrative Assistant; Danya Peterson, AgriLife Extension Agent; Xane Reiter, Elections Administrator, Kim Wilks, Giles W. Dalby and Voda Gradine, Post Dispatch.

Judge Norman called the Regular Meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Order 1: Prayer

Order 3: Public Comment

Order 4: Minutes from the November 14, 2022 regular meeting were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Morris. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

Sheriff Morgan: Jail inmate count; 76, 27 are county inmates and 49 out of county.

Danya Peterson, AgriLife Extension Agent: Reported activities. They have started their canned food drive for Trailblazers. Locations will be at Courthouse, Extension Office and Family Cleaners.

Judge Norman: Reported the latest count at the Dalby Unit. Brought in 400 prisoners in the first two weeks. About the end of the second week the State of Texas came in and took about a hundred. Thanks to County Treasurer, Appraisal District and Mr. Weems the Sheriff's Office Certificates of Obligation were renewed. Received an A+ rating. See attachment. Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Williams to accept the reports as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

Order 7: Came on for consideration was repair of Garza County Museum Front. A motion was made by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Morris to approve repairs of the concrete in front of museum. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

Order 8: Came on for consideration was to approve the Advertising of Bids on Courtroom chairs. A motion was made by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Morris to approve the advertising of bids. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.



Order 9: Canvass Votes for November 8, 2022 Election. Members of the court compared the figures on the tally sheet with the figures on the results sheet for the November 8, 2022 General Election. Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Williams to approve the election returns. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.
