A regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, November 25, 2019 beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, Texas with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners, Pct.1-Jeff Williams, Pct. 2-Charles Morris, Pct.3-Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham.

County officials present: Jim Plummer, District and County Clerk; Ted Weems, Attorney; Terry Morgan, Sheriff; Nancy Wallace, Tax Assessor/Collector; and LuAnne Terry, Treasurer.

Also present: Carol Williams, Administrative Assistant; Michael Isbell, Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC); Linda Puckett, County Historical Museum; Terry Bartlett, Post Economic Development Coordinator (PEDC); and Dakota McDonald, Post Dispatch.

Judge Norman called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Order 1: Minutes from the November 13, 2019 special and regular meetings were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Benham. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

Order 2: Reports from county offices - The following items of information were brought before the Court as a written and/or a verbal report:

- a. EMC Michael Isbell: reported on an auto accident a week ago and the result of the contents spilt from a milk truck and the clean-up process keeping the milk from negatively affecting the city's south lake. Also, Jimmy Valdez is the new Post fire chief.
- b. Sheriff Morgan: There has been record high inmate revenue in recent months. The jail inmate count is at 87, 26 are county inmates. Discussed a recent arrest of a domestic terrorist from Washington state which received national attention. Also, a county sheriff's deputy broke up a child abduction out of Lubbock. (Attachment)
- c. Budget Analysis Usage Report
- d. Clerk
- e. Justice of the Peace - Pct. 1
- f. County Court Monthly - Office of Court Administration (Oct)
- g. District Court Monthly - Office of Court Administration (Oct)

Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Benham to accept the reports as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Written reports are attached.)

- Order 3: Came on for consideration was the precinct and countywide accounts payable for November 14, 2019 through November 25, 2019. Motion was made by Commissioner Brannon and seconded by Commissioner Williams that all accounts presented in the fund requirement print-out is ordered paid and presented to the Treasurer for payment. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Attachment)
- Order 4: Came on for presentation was the Garza County Accident Prevention Plan. Attorney Weems explained the original plan was revised to suit a small county. He endorsed the presented plan. Commissioner Williams inquired about record keeping obligations concerning county equipment. Clerk Plummer asked for Chief Deputy Clerk Ginger Clemmons be removed as a committee member. Motion was made by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Brannon to approve the accident prevention plan as amended. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Attachment)
- Order 5: Came on before the court was Linda Puckett, curator of the Garza County Historical Museum with the yearend report. Motion was made by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Benham to accept the report. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Attachment)
- Order 6: Came on for ratification was the Statewide Automated Victims Notification Service (SAVNS) Maintenance Grant Contract between the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) and Garza County for the state fiscal year 2020. Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Williams to ratify OAG Contract No. 20192044900-376-01. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Attachment)
- Order 7: Came on for consideration was the 2020 Texas VINE agreement between the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) and Garza County for the state fiscal year 2020. The cost is paid by the Texas Attorney General's office. Attorney Weems reviewed the contract and recommended that the court approve the renewal of the contract. Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Brannon to approve OAG Contract No. 2003333. With a

majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Attachment)

Order 8: Came on for consideration was a Tax Deed for lot 34, in the Alexander Addition of the Original Town of Post, Garza County, Texas. The bid is from Emilie Hegdahl for \$400. Attorney Weems recommended approving the bid. Motion was made by Commissioner Benham seconded by Commissioner Brannon to approve the tax deed as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Attachment)

Order 9: Came on for consideration was line item corrections and budget amendment requests. None presented.

Order 10: Public Comment  
Terry Bartlett of PEDC informed the court the home construction project is moving along.


The meeting adjourned at 9:27 a.m.





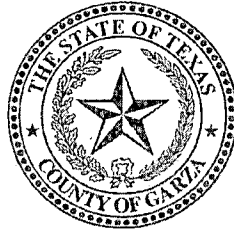
