County officials present: Jim Plummer, District and County Clerk; Ted Weems, Attorney; Nancy Wallace, Tax Collector/Assessor; and LuAnne Terry, Treasurer. Also present: Carol Williams, Administrative Assistant; Terry Bartlett, Post Economic Development Corporation (PEDC) & Post Area Chamber of Commerce (PACC) and Dakota McDonald, Post Dispatch.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m.

Order 1: Canvass the November 5, 2019 Constitutional Amendment Election

The canvass was certified as presented with a motion by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Benham.


With all commissioners present and the judge voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (The Canvass Certification and Election Returns are attached.)




JEFF WILLIAMS, COMMISSIONER PCT. 1
